Lions of Michigan Foundation receives grant from Joe D. Pentecost Foundation to purchase equipment for its vision screening program for children.

Lansing, Michigan – April 2017 – The Lions of Michigan Foundation has received a \$7,000 grant from the Joe D. Pentecost Foundation to purchase a Spot VS-100 Vision Screener for its KIDSight Program. This new hand held vision screener quickly and accurately detects all common vision disorders in children, including near sightedness, far sightedness and astigmatism and more serious vision disorder like amblyopia that if not detected and treated early in a child’s life can cause permanent vision loss. The new equipment will help the Lions of Michigan Foundation achieve its goal of ensuring that no child in Michigan suffers permanent vision loss or experiences academic and social development difficulties due to an undetected or untreated vision disorder.

“The Lions Club’s free eye screening was a blessing to our family. Victoria had a juvenile cataract in her left eye. The doctors believe she was born with a defect in the back of her eye, and it was never identified during her well-child check-ups.
